Your beat team was really very busy the last few days.

Please have a look some of the jobs which completed across the beat:

- Patrolled a large amount of our villages offering Hi-visibility patrols in both vehicle and on foot.
- Attended a report of a suspicious vehicle.
- Multiple referrals done to the Council in relation to fly tipping.
- A statement has been taken in relation to an incident of assault, enquiries are ongoing.
- Enquiries completed in relation to an incident of anti-social behaviour.
- Following a report received of concern for welfare of drunk persons in road, on attendance no persons were found in the road or putting themselves or others in danger.

tended a report of child screaming. Upon attendance this was not as reported and relevant referrals made to support child and family.

- Number of vehicles have been stopped and checks completed. Amongst these a motorcyclist who was driving carelessly was stopped and strong words of advice was given.
- Number of crime queue enquiries and visits of local stores.
- We will be booking off soon for the night and leaving you in the hands of the night shift response teams who will be out and about the local area.
- Recovered a stolen car.
- Conducted a beat Surgery at Newbold Verdon Library.
- Attended an address following concerns raised and highlighted safeguarding issues in Groby.
- Meeting with the Anti-social behaviour team from Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council in relation to ongoing ASB issues across the beat.
- Crime enquiries conducted in regards to a stolen vehicle- enquiries ongoing.
- Intelligence submitted and paperwork completed.
- Visited multiple schools on the area to deliver road safety leaflets.
- Recovered a caravan that was reported stolen in 2019.
- Abandoned moped has been found checks was completed which show the vehicle as stolen. bike subsequently recovered.
- Conducted a Beat Surgery at Desford Library.
- Made enquiries about various neighbourhood issues.
- Visited and dealt with a suspect of an assault which happened in a local school.
- A number of vehicles have been stopped and driver and vehicle details checked.
- Safeguarding visits have been completed and referrals made.
- Made enquiries in relation to an incident of criminal damage, this is still ongoing.



- Visited a victim of anti-social behaviour and following this a visit was made to one of the youths involved. We will be working Hinckley and Bosworth borough Council in regards to the incremental approach with dealing with the youths.
- Colleagues from our road traffic department have been out across the area. A moped has been stopped and found not to be road legal since 2016!! Bike has been seized and rider reported.
- Patrols completed in ASB hot-spot locations.
- Attended Kidspace nursery in Markfield where we were invited to talk to a number of young children about the role of a Police officer.



- Visited a number of local stores and spoke regarding local shop thefts.
- Spoke to a number of local residents.
- Attended an address and recovered an Air rifle which has been subsequently booked in for destruction.
- Visited a number of local schools across the area.
- Enquiries ongoing in relation to a report of parking issues outside local schools.
- Submitted multiple intelligence into the Police systems.
- Attended a report of another assault between school students.
- Attended Startins in Twycross.
- Enquiries made in regards to reports of trouble with youths on E-scooters and Off road motorcycle.
- Hi-visibility patrols completed in a many of our villages we cover.
- We assist our response officers in multiple occasions.
- Multiple tasks has been completed regarding crimes across the beat area.
