QUEEN ELIZABETH II ROSE GARDEN

The Queen Elizabeth II Rose Garden is located on Stamford Park in Groby and has been created as a place where you can dedicate a rose bush in memory of a loved one and place an inscribed memorial plaque.

There are 3 rose beds within the Rose Garden which have been named Balmoral, Windsor and Sandringham. Within each rose bed, 10 different varieties of floribunda rose bushes have been planted.

In order to dedicate a rose bush, you will purchase a rose garden package and the fee will cover a period of 10 years. The package will include your chosen rose bush, a black granite memorial plaque, inscribed with words of your choosing, placed on the wooden sleepers located to the rear of each rose bed, and an identification tag which will be engraved with the name of your loved one and attached to the individual rose bush.

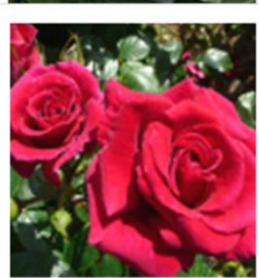

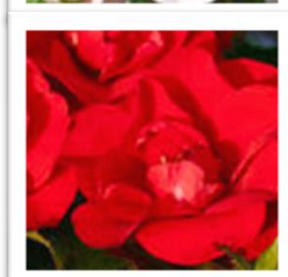

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QUEEN ELIZABETH II ROSE GARDEN RULES and REGULATIONS

- **NO** scattering of ashes is permitted within the Queen Elizabeth II Rose Garden
- **NO** additional items or plants/bulbs are permitted within the Rose Garden. Any items in breach of this agreement will be removed and retained by the Parish Council for safekeeping.
- The fee will cover a period of 10 years which will include the purchase and planting of a rose; the purchasing and engraving of a plaque; the purchasing and engraving of an identification tag and maintenance of the rose and plaque for 10 years.
- If the rose should die in the period covered by the payment, the rose will be replaced at a cost to the Parish Council.
- The fee will be payable in full on application.
- If the 10 year period lapses and there is no renewal of the contract, the Parish Council will retain the plaque for safekeeping but will re-use the rose in the garden.
- If at the end of the 10 years the applicant wishes to keep the plaque they can do so by arrangement with the Parish Clerk.
- The applicant may, if they wish, renew the contract for another 10 years for the fee listed at the time of renewal.
- The rose and plaque will be planted and maintained by the Parish Council.
- The applicant is advised to inform the Parish Council of any change of address in order to enable contact to be made when renewal is due.
