#YOU SAID, WE DID

You said: Anti-social behaviour was a priority.

Members of the Beat Team have been patrolling key hotspots this month with officers issuing multiple warning letters with the assistance of the Anti-Social behaviour team from the council to repeat and key offenders in the area. We are pleased to report that there has been a decrease in anti-social behaviour occurrences across the beat. You said: Road safety continues to be an issue.

Officers from the Market Bosworth Beat Team attended a meeting alongside local councillors in Stoke Golding to discuss speeding issues in and around the area. Multiple issues were raised including speeding and parking with plans in place to find a positive result to both.

You said: Rural Crime is priority.

Rural Crime officer PC Statt has been busy this summer with an increase presence in the local area due to the harvest. Members of the Beat Team alongside the Rural crime team have continued to patrol around key hotspot areas for offenders in the area.

What we are doing

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in September 2023.

Priority 1: Road Safety

You said: That Road Safety issues are your number 1 concern.

What we are going to do: Continue to seize vehicles that are driving on our road with no Insurance and no Tax.

Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

You Said: Anti-Social Behaviour including use of motorbikes on open spaces was an issue to you.

What we are going to do: Continue to patrol across the beat to prevent any ASB issues, as well as continue to work closely with our partners.
