What matters to you

#YOU SAID, WE DID

You said: Anti-social behaviour was a priority.

The Beat Team have been working in partnership with Hinckley and Bosworth Council this month tackling repeat anti-social behaviour issues and offenders. Both teams have been working collaboratively to take action against those that are causing harassment alarm and distress on our beat with many positive results recorded in the last month.

You said: Road safety continues to be an issue

This month we have seen a rise in road traffic collisions mainly due to the change in weather conditions. Residents are reminded to stay safe and alert when driving and to be conscious of other road users.

You said: Rural Crime is priority.

Pc Mike Statt , Market Bosworth Rural Crime officer, has been very busy this month alongside the rest of the team following a rise in break-ins across the areas. Residents are reminded to stay vigilant when locking their doors and windows at night and to report any suspicious activity on 101 or 999 in an emergency.

What we are doing

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in October 2023.

Priority 1: Road Safety

You said: That Road Safety issues are your number 1 concern.

What we are going to do: Work with partnership agencies such as Market Bosworth Fire Service to tackle Road safety issues.

Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

You Said: Anti-Social Behaviour including use of motorbikes on open spaces was an issue to you.

What we are going to do: Patrol key hotspot areas for anti-social behaviour and continue to gather intelligence to take action against those who are persistent offenders.

OP FORTUNE - Enforcement!

Earlier this week we took enforcement action against those offending on our area!

Following investigation into a series of House Burglaries across the Hinckley, Blaby and Market Bosworth areas where properties were being broken into so that car keys could be obtained, allowing the offenders to then steal the cars outside a break through of our own was achieved.

Local Officers applied to Magistrates Court for warrants to search 2 industrial units in the West Midlands area and a team of officers raided both units.

The action led to the arrest of 1 male and the seizure of a number of car parts that are from stolen vehicles. These stolen car parts are linked to vehicles stolen from across the country including London, Yorkshire and Manchester as well as 1 vehicle stolen from Scotland! The investigation continues.

We would encourage our community to consider the use of other prevention measures such as house alarms, steering wheel locks or tracking devices to help protect your property.
